





Renewing EAfA

Strengthen the quality, supply and image of apprenticeships in Europe

Promote the mobility of apprentices





By bringing together governments, social partners, businesses, chambers, regions, youth organisations, VET providers and think tanks, the reinforced EAfA will unlock decisive actions by all actors and will be in particular:

Promoting national apprenticeships coalitions / green and digital pledges

Supporting SMEs

Mobilising local and regional authorities

Reinforcing the involvement of social partners including at sectoral level

Supporting the representation of apprentices in the Member States
